

# Butterfly Mobile

**Berol**  
by Paper Mate

## You will need:

- Berol Colour Broad Felt Tip Pens
- Berol Handwriting Pencil
- Butterfly Template
- White Card
- Double-sided sticky tape
- Scissors
- Needle and thread
- Twigs
- Hole punch
- Pipe Cleaners

## What to do?

1. Fold a piece of A4 card in half and cut along the fold. (This will make 2 butterflies. You will need 3 or more butterflies for your mobile)
2. Fold each of the pieces of card in half and draw half a butterfly along the folded line and cut them out.
3. Using your colouring pens, design your butterfly wings with circles, dots or zig zag lines.
4. Using the template cut out the butterfly body and punch 2 holes for the eyes. Colour the body in black.
5. Cut a pipe cleaner in half and thread it through the holes as butterfly's antennae.
6. Use the sticky tape to attach the body to the wings.
7. Using a needle, pull a length of knotted thread through the balancing point of each butterfly, near its centre. Make each length of thread slightly different so the butterflies hang at different heights.
8. Tie one butterfly to each end of the twig and another butterfly in the centre of the twig.
9. Your mobile is complete and ready to hang up with a piece of thread.
