



## AIR DRYING CLAY Modelling

Children can enjoy the experience of using clay with no need for the expense or safety issues of a kiln. Dries hard when exposed to air.

Colours: Stone, Terracotta or White.

### ADDITIONAL INFO

- Suitable for age 36 months+. Adult supervision recommended.
- A natural product, some of which is mined locally in Staffordshire, the home of the Potteries and Shropshire.
- Can be moulded, shaped and stretched.
- Use with modelling tools and textured plates.
- Explores understanding of basic concepts – hard/soft, wet/dry.
- Does not contain Sulphur.
- Typical shrinkage is around 12% wet or dry.
- If partially air dried, can be reconstituted by soaking a towel and covering the clay with cling film for 24hrs
- Wheat and Gluten free.

### IDEAS/HINTS & TIPS

Finished models can be decorated with almost any paint and given a coat of PVA or varnish to give a glossy finish. Improves hand strength which prepares fingers for pen and pencil use in the future.

Can also be kiln dried.

Temps: Earthenware 1120 degrees c; Stoneware 1250 degrees c.

12.5kg, 1kg & 4.5kg contains nylon fibres to give extra strength to the finished pieces. Fibres burn away if kiln dried.
